PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO P.G. DEGREE COURSE (SELF FINANCING) IN ENGINEERING FOR THE YEAR 2018 (Extracted from GO(MS)No. 115/2018/HEDN Dt. 31/05/2018)

I. General

Post Graduate Degree Courses in Engineering are being offered to the graduates in Engineering, in Mar Athanasius College of Engineering offering Masters degree in Computer Aided Structural Engineering in Civil Engineering Department and Production and Industrial Engineering in Mechanical Engineering Department by the APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University under Self Financing scheme. The course shall extend over a period of 24 months consisting of 4 semesters.

II. Intake

The total number of seats for P.G. Course in Computer Aided Structural Engineering and Production & Industrial Engineering is 18 each. For filling up the 50% merit seats eligible candidates will be selected from the applicants based on the Rank list published by the Directorate of Technical Education complying the reservation norms as mentioned in clause IV of the prospectus. In the absence of candidates in the rank list, other eligible candidates will be considered.

IV. Reservation of seats

- a) 5% Seats are reserved for candidates belonging to socially and Educational Backward Classes (SEBC). Candidates belonging to SEBC (OBC) and OEC should produce a certificate to the extent that the candidate belongs to the community which is designated as an SEBC (OBC) / OEC and does not belong to the category of Creamy Layer.
- b) 15% Seats are reserved for SC/ST Candidates.
- c) The seats reserved for each category will be distributed among the eligible communities by observing the pattern of general reservation rules of the state.
- d) 3% seats are reserved for physically handicapped candidates.
- e) 50% seats will be allotted under relating to management quota.

V. Eligibility for admission

- a) The candidates shall be an Indian National.
- b) The candidates should have studied the Graduate course in an institution approved by the AICTE / Deemed Universities in India.
- c) Candidates should have a minimum of 60% aggregate marks in the Engineering Degree examination. For SC/ST candidates a pass in the Engineering Degree course is sufficient. For SEBC (OBC) students, a minimum of 54% aggregate marks in the Engineering Degree examination is mandatory.
- d) Candidates, who have passed AMIE / AMIETE Examinations and satisfying the following conditions, are eligible for admission.
 - 1) They must have valid GATE score.
 - 2) A minimum of 55% marks for section B in AMIE/AMIETE examination.
- e) Candidates who have appeared for the final semester examination can also apply, provided he / she has passed all the subjects up to and including the 6th semester exam. Confirmation of admission of such candidates shall be subject to the production of qualifying degree before the date stipulated by the affiliated University.
- f) Admission shall normally be restricted to those with valid GATE score. However, this stipulation is relaxed in the case of Sponsored candidates.
- g) In case seats remain vacant due to lack of candidates with valid GATE score, candidates from Kerala State without valid GATE score will be considered against such vacancies. If seats are still remaining vacant, candidates from other states will be considered for admission.

VII. Submission of Applications

Application forms can be downloaded from the college website. A printout of the filled up application should be taken and sent with self attested copies of the following documents and application fee of Rs.500/- by Crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of the **Principal, Mar Athanasius College of Engineering** payable at **Kothamangalam to the Principal, Mar Athanasius College of Engineering, Kothamangalam, 689 666.**

- Engineering Degree certificate and Mark lists up to 6th semester for B.Tech students. Those who are appearing for final examination this year must produce mark list up to 6th Semester
- GATE Score card (for Candidates with valid GATE Score) Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the village officer for candidates who claim eligibility under SEBC (OBC) quota.
- Community Certificate issued by the Tahsildar for candidates who claim eligibility for reservation under SC/ST quota.
- The candidates who belong to OEC category should submit the Community and Non Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the Tahsildar/Village Officer, Sponsorship Certificate (if applicable).
- Physical disability certificate (if applicable).
- Diploma Certificate for B.Tech Lateral Entry students.

VIII. Selection of Candidates

- The Rank List will be prepared in accordance with the rank of DTE from the applied candidates.
- In the absence of candidates from the DTE's rank list the following procedure followed;
If sufficient GATE qualified candidates are not available, the selection will be made from Keralite candidates based on the aggregate marks up to 6th semester in their qualifying examination. Candidates who produce Nativity Certificate in original obtained as per Annexure- C, at the time of admission will only be admitted in this case. A Rank List will be published based on the GATE Score/Percentage

of marks. Candidates are requested to verify their branch/Marks/Category etc. at the time of publishing draft Rank List. After finalizing the Rank List, any alternation on those factors will not be entertained under any circumstances.

- c) Allotment list will be published in the website - www.mac.ac.in
- d) Allotment letter will be sent to the candidates.
- e) Sponsored candidates, if any, will be admitted as per relevant Government Orders.
- f) Transfer Certificate issued from the institutions last attended must be produced at the time of admission.
- g) The selection of candidates will be provisional and subject to verification of original documents at the time of admission.

IX. Remittance of fee.

- a) The fee for a course allotted to the candidate will have to be paid within the admission time.
- b) Refund of fee will be applicable only to students who leave the college on cancellation of admission. No interest will be paid to the candidates.

XI. Liquidated Damages

- a) Admission for this institution will be after the date of 1st allotment by DTE. All students leaving this institution after the closing date of admission announced by Directorate of Technical Education will have to pay liquidated damages plus tuition fee and special fee for the remaining period of the course.
- b) In all such cases the Transfer Certificate will be issued only after remitting the liquidated damages to the authority concerned. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC are exempted from this rule.

XII. Spot Admission

- a) A spot admission will be conducted by the College for the vacant seats. All students in the rank list are eligible to appear for spot admission. Candidates selected through spot admission will have to join the institutions on the date specified by remitting the required fees at the College.

- b) Those who are admitted through spot admission shall produce No Objection Certificate from the Principals of respective institutions. All other candidates should produce Original Certificates/ mark lists at the time of spot admission.

XIII. Scholarship

Scholarship is available for candidates with valid GATE Score as per AICTE norms for the total period of 24 months subject to the following conditions.

- a. Each student shall undertake 8 to 10 hours of work per week related to teaching and research activities as assigned by the College.
- b. The student shall give an undertaking to the effect that he/she will not leave the course midway or appear for any Competitive examination not related to Engineering and Technology.
- c. The students shall not receive any emoluments, salary, stipend etc. from any other source during the course of study.
- d. The Students eligible to receive Gate Scholarship should have valid bank account which is linked with their Aadhar card number.
- d. SC/ST students will be eligible for stipend as per Kerala State Government Rules.

Any other details not specifically covered by the clauses given above will be decided by the Principal and his/her decision will be final. Principal is also empowered to cancel any admission found to be illegal subsequent to the admission.
